

Traveller's Journal: The Cover

You will need:

Outer fabric (Laura used a quilt) 9" x 14" (23cm x 36cm)

Lining (Laura used a hand dyed cotton fabric) 9" x 14" (23cm x 36cm)

Square pocket (Laura cut this from more quilted fabric) 5" x 5" (13cm x 13cm)

Two triangle pockets, cut a 5" (13cm) square in half diagonally

Binding, cut a long strip 1.5" x 90" (4cm x 228cm). That should be more than enough. No need to cut on the bias, straight-grain strips are fine. Join shorter strips as required.

50" (128cm) 2mm elastic cord

Machine sewing thread

Basic sewing kit

Sewing machine capable of eyelets or buttonholes

Tip:

Use a small scrap of your outer fabric to test and practise making the eyelets/buttonholes before you work on your project piece.
